Judging and Awards

Trips will be awarded with a maximum of \$1500 each (total in awards not to exceed \$6000). Each winner will be invited to the NETA Spring Conference on Thursday, April 24, 2008, to be recognized at the opening general session and the teacher’s school district will be reimbursed up to \$100 to pay for a substitute on Thursday so the teacher may attend the award ceremony. (Principal’s consent required.)

All winners will receive notification of contest results via email by March 1, 2008 at the email address provided on the entry form. Conference information will be sent to winning teachers via US mail at a later date. **Teachers should NOT register for the conference until winners are announced.** All products submitted become property of NETA, and may be distributed freely.

Fine print: Up to \$1500 will be awarded for conference registration, coach class airfare, hotel and meals to attend NECC 2008 in San Antonio. Up to 4 winners will be chosen! (See special note on page 21.)
